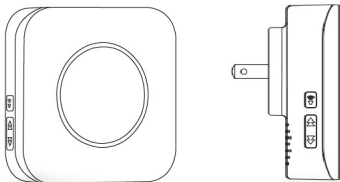

- ❑ **Multiple Connections** — The video doorbell can support up to 50 extender pairs, allowing you to optimize for a larger living space

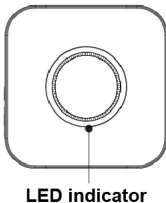
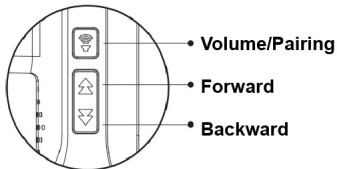
## **How the Extender System Works !**



## ■ Before you begin




- ✓ The place where you want to install the extender should be covered by your home Wi-Fi signal.
- ✓ Your mobile device must be connected to the same Wi-Fi which the extender will connect to, (only **2.4GHz** networks are supported).
- ✓ Ensure that Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device.

## ■ Manual operation

Buttons	Operation
<b>Volume/ Pairing</b> 	Short press to adjust the volume; 4-level volume adjustment Hold and press until the red light is flashing slowly to indicate pairing mode. then add to the Smart Life APP
<b>Backward</b> 	Short press to select the ringtone backward
<b>Forward</b> 	Short press to select the ringtone forward

## ■ Q&A

**Q:** Will using this doorbell extender cause any delay?

**A:** If your video doorbell is hardwired, responses will be real-time. For battery-powered models, you may experience a delay of a few seconds. This is intentional by design to conserve battery life and cannot be adjusted.

**Q: How do I set the product to silent mode (0 dB)?**

**A:** Configure the alert style to "Light" in the Amazon Alexa app. For step-by-step instructions, please refer to **Step 5** in the User Manual.

**Q: How do I add multiple extra doorbell extenders?**

**A:** If you'd like to add one or more extra doorbell extenders, you can do it in just two simple steps:

**1) Add the extra extender(s) to SmartLife, following **Step 2:****

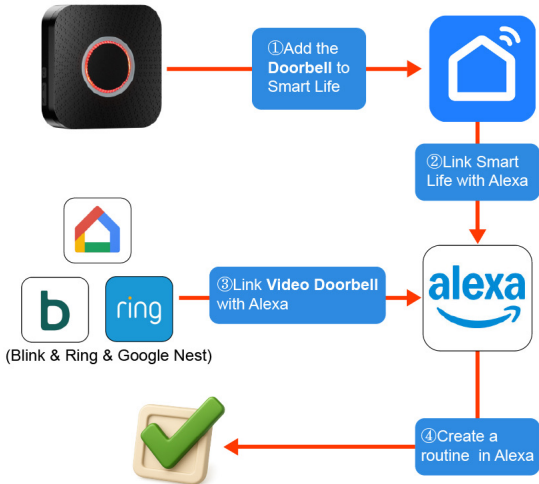

**2) Set up your extender(s) in Alexa, following **Step 5:****
