■ Step 1 : Download the APP

- 1.1** Download the "Smart Life" & " Alexa " app from Apple App Store or Google Play to your phone (If already downloaded, skip.)
- 1.2** Create "Smart Life" & " Alexa "account (If registered, skip.)
- 1.3** Download "Blink" app (If already downloaded, skip.)



■ Step 2 : Add the Doorbell Extender to Smart Life


2.1 Plug in & Power up

Plug the Video Doorbell Extender into an outlet.



2.2 Pairing Doorbell Extender

2.2.1 Press and hold the Ring tone button  on the device until the indicator is flashing red .







2.2.2 Open the "Smart Life" app click the "+" button on the top right corner, select "Add Device"




2.2.3 Click "Wireless Doorbell" and Add

2.3 Enter Wi-Fi password (Note: suggestion match your phone's Wi-Fi). (only supported **2.4GHz** networks)




■ Step 3 : Link Smart Life with Alexa


3.1 Open the Smart Life app:




① Click the

② select "More assistants"




③ locate and select "Alexa"

④ select "Link to Amazon Alexa" ⑤ select "Link" ⑥ select "Done"




■ Step 4 : Link Blink with Alexa


4-1 Open the **Blink app,

logged in, please skip)**




4-2 Click the ' **Settings ' in the navigation bar.

Blink Alexa Skill will be turned on so you can hear Blink alerts and answer the door through Alexa devices.

Once you link your Blink account with an Amazon account, anyone who has access to that Amazon account may access your Blink devices and videos on compatible devices.




Link Blink SmartHome with Alexa





■ Step 5 : Set up Alexa

① Open the **Alexa** app





② Click the **≡**

Then Create Routine





Alexa can perform a series of actions, like reading the weather and turning on the lights, with a single command.


